Samaagam 2025

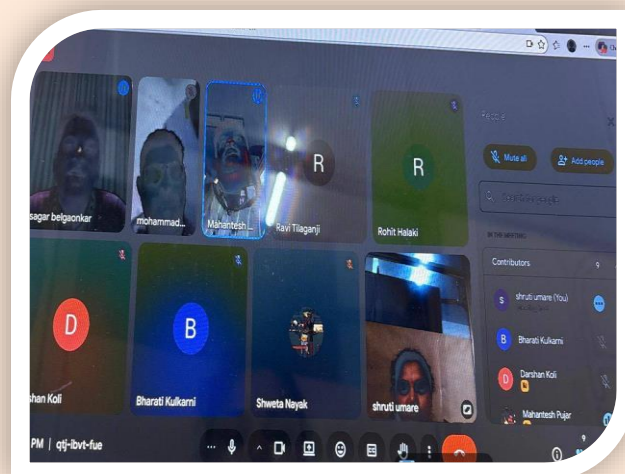
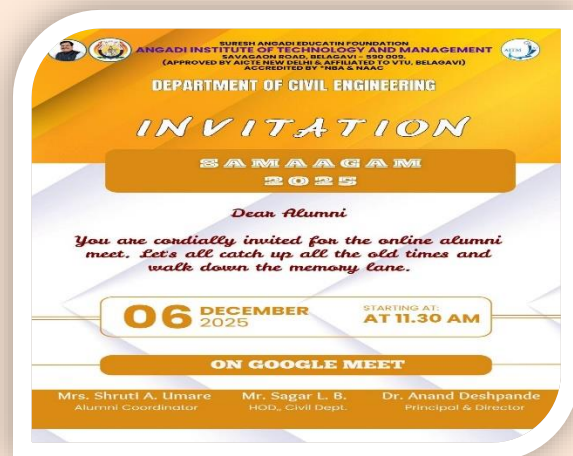

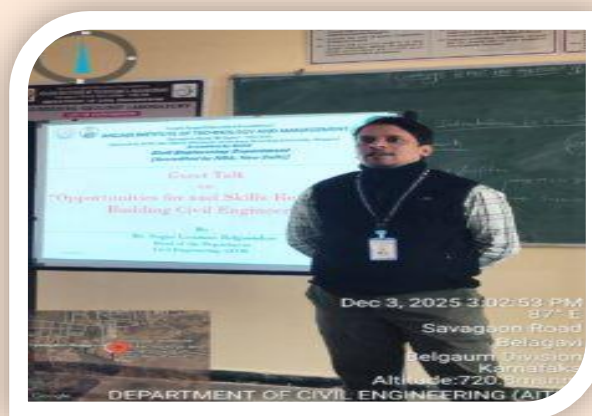
Expert Talk on "Opportunities for and Skills Required by Civil Engineers."
