Orientation Program for Academic Year 2025-2026

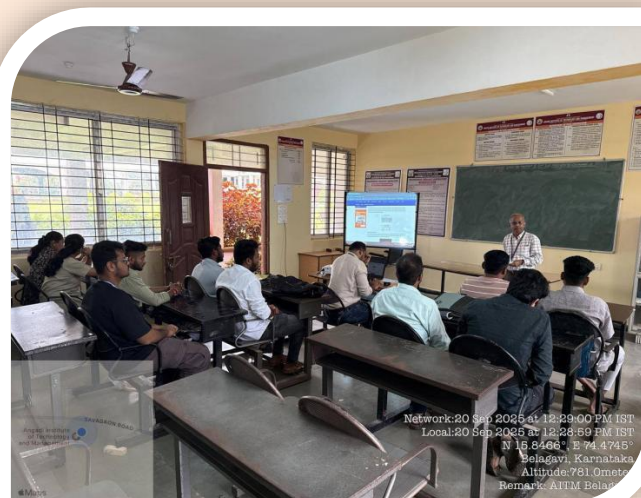
On September 20, 2025, the orientation program for third-semester students of the Civil Engineering Department was conducted.

Overall, the orientation program facilitated a productive introduction and interaction among the department's faculty members and students.

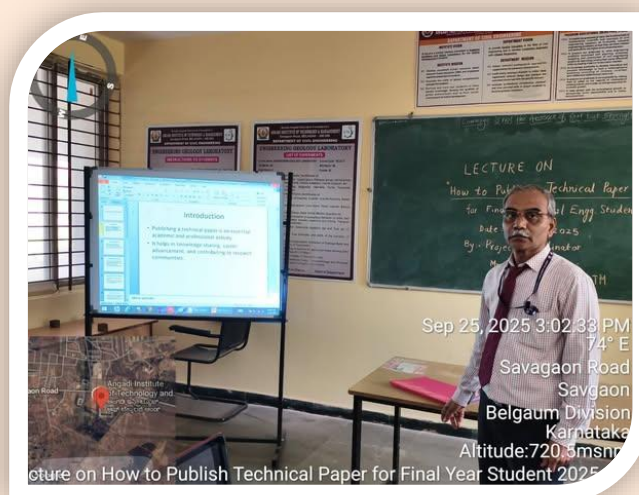




Seminar
